

'Kinochaya' opens in Otemachi

We proudly serve seven types of sencha, a hojicha and two types of matcha, all selected from high-quality tea produced in Japan. We also offer a range of desserts including matcha ice cream, a tea-master concoction and a number one favourite at the Shinjuku shop, as well as new menu items such as tokoroten (flavoured gelidium jelly noodle), seasonal gelato and anmitsu (agar jelly cubes with sweet azuki bean paste).
